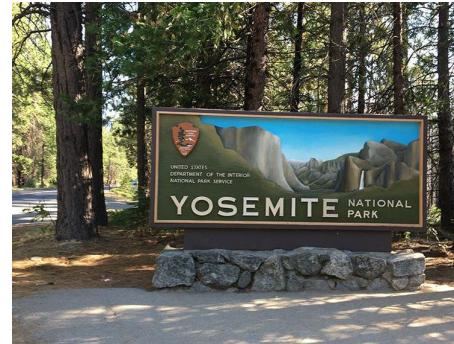
Important and Timely Vacation Planner Material is Coming Your Way!

National Park Service Proposes Targeted Fee Increases at Parks to Address Maintenance Backlog -- NPCA is Taking Action and Would Like Your Help

The National Park Service is [proposing to raise entrance fees](#) during peak visitation season in 17 national parks, including Yosemite, to increase revenue to help address deferred maintenance backlog in the parks. If the proposal is accepted and implemented, the private vehicle entrance fee for Yosemite would increase from \$30 per vehicle to \$70 per vehicle (133% increase)! Commercial tour services into Yosemite will also experience rate increases.



The National Park Conservation Association (NPCA) has developed a campaign to ask the Executive Administration to work with Congress to not burden park visitors with higher park fees and to look for more sensible and long-term solutions to address maintenance backlog in the parks.

NPCA has written the following business letter to Secretary of the Interior, Ryan Zinke, and they're looking to gain co-signers before Tuesday, November 21st.
