70 41 West Yaney Avenue
TUOLUMNE COUNTY COURTHOUSE
Construction started in 1898 on this three-story Roman pressed brick building erected on the site of the first courthouse, an 1853 wooden building. The new building cost \$105,000, including furnishings. It is local legend that Architect William Mosser, Jr. of San Francisco reoriented the building's facade toward Yaney Avenue so the new building would face the home of lumber baron S. S. Bradford. This building is on the National Register of Historic Places.



37 Theall Street
SUGG-McDONALD HOUSE
The original portion of this home was built in 1857 from adobe-type bricks made on the property by former slave William Sugg. The home was expanded with wood to two stories as the family grew. Later it was a boarding house. Sugg's descendants owned and occupied this home for over 120 years. This building is on the National Register of Historic Places.




19 72 North Norton Street
GADY HOUSE
This Greek revival home is perched on Piery Hill and is buttressed by a wall of native slate. This pioneer home came to Sonora as numbered pieces and was reconstructed here in the 1850s. Charles Haley, an Afro-American, may have been its first owner, followed by J. S. Cady, who sold wallpaper and paint in the Old Fellows building nearby. This home is on the National Register of Historic Places.



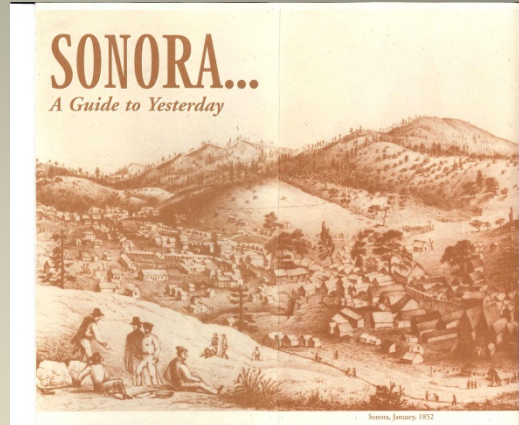
27 SOUTH STEWART STREET

313 Stewart Street • NICOL HOME
The Nicol home, now apartments, was the home of G. W. Nicol, a native son and attorney who served as Tuolumne County Superior Court Judge for 32 years after his election in 1890. Originally built in 1885 and the home of Judge Nicol's wife, Julia, before her marriage. This old house's stately exterior is notable for numerous square bay windows, a pair of sculptured chimneys and a wrought iron fence. A ballroom was once on the top floor.
