Tanager, Western
Eats insects at top of trees



Towhee, Spotted
Solitary, forages on ground



Turkey, Wild
Roosts in trees at night



Vulture, Turkey
Most often seen in flight



Warbler, Yellow-rumped
Only warbler likely in winter



Waxwing, Cedar
Loves dogwood berries



Woodpecker, Acorn
Stores acorns in tree holes



Woodpecker, Downy
Smallest woodpecker



Woodpecker, Pileated
Found on dead trees/logs



Wren, Bewick's
Common in brushy habitat



Wren, Northern House
Nests in cavities

Blackbird, Brewer's
Med., Glossy, Yellow Eye

Small groups, open space

Chickadee, Mountain
Aspen and conifer forests

Cowbird, Brown-headed
Found in open woodlands

Dove, Mourning
Usually in small groups

Duck, Mallard
Most common duck species

Finch, House
Nests on or near buildings

Large woodpecker

Goldfinch, Lesser
Usually seen in flocks

Goose, Canada
Found near bodies of water

Grosbeak, Black-headed
Found in mature woods

Hawk, Cooper's
Hunts small birds in flight

Hawk, Red-shouldered
Perched in clearing near water

Hawk, Red-tailed
Perched on roadside posts

Heron, Great-blue
Grassy fields to shallow water

Hummingbird, Anna's
Near plantings & flowers

Jay, California Scrub
Feeds mainly on acorns

Jay, Stellar's
Likes shady, dense forest

Junco, Dark-eyed
Familiar winter visitor

Kestrel, American
Hovers, drops straight down

Kingfisher, Belted
Near water with sm. fish

Kinglet, Ruby-crowned
Found in low brush

Nuthatch, White-breasted
Climbs head-down on trunk

Owl, Great-horned
Roosts in trees during day

☐ ☐


Owl, Western Screech
Found in open woodlands

Phoebe, Black
Found on low open perch

☐ ☐


Quail, California
Dense brush, thickets

Raven, Common
Usually found in pairs

Robin, American
Found on grassy lawns

Sparrow, White-crowned
Winters in flocks in brush
