

SET YOUR COMPASS TO *Wander*

Tuolumne County (too-all-o-me) located 133 miles/200 km east of San Francisco, is a pristine, scenic expanse reaching from the heart of California's Gold Country in the rolling foothills to the granite, tree-lined peaks of the Sierra Nevada Mountains. The main highways leading to the picturesque drive from the San Francisco and East Bay Area are Highways 108 and 120 from the west and Highway 49 from the north. The State Highway 120 entrance to Yosemite National Park is considered the "front door" of the park for the San Francisco Greater Bay Area. The Stanislaus National Forest, Yosemite National Park and other surrounding areas provide authentic historic sites, natural vistas, and opportunities for every outdoor enthusiast.

MUST-DO ACTIVITIES BY TOWN

Sonora – Explore shops, galleries, and museums. Enjoy live music at 2nd Saturday Art Night, sip craft cider at Indigeny Reserve, catch a top-tier live show at Sierra Repertory Theatre, try an escape room, and snap photos on the Sonora Selfie Trail.

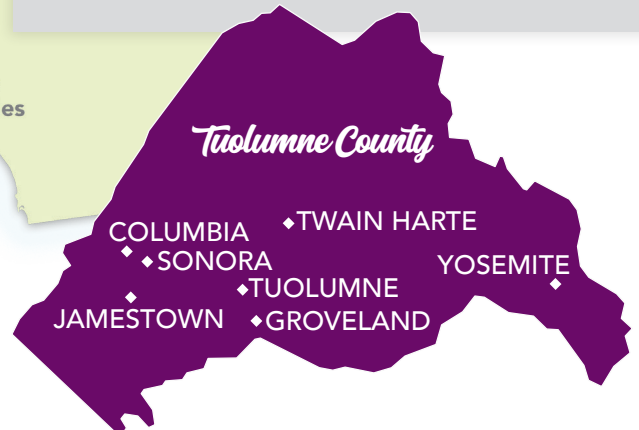
Groveland – Discover unique shops, galleries, and the historic Iron Door Saloon, California's longest-operating saloon. Visit the Groveland Yosemite Gateway Museum, hike the trails on the Stanislaus National Forest, golf at Pine Mountain Lake, raft whitewater rapids, and enjoy craft beer, made with water from Yosemite at Around the Horn Brewing Co.

Twain Harte – An Audubon Bird Town! Play mini golf on a vintage course, enjoy live music at Concerts in the Pines during the summer, visit Pinecrest Lake for outdoor adventures. Go snow tubing at Leland Snowplay and ski at Dodge Ridge Mountain Resort in the winter.

Jamestown – Shop for antiques and dine in the historic town, ride a train at Railtown 1897 State Historic Park, explore the Walk of Fame, hike Red Hills Recreation Area, stay and play at Chicken Ranch Casino Resort, and enjoy local wine and beer.

Columbia – Step into immersive Gold Rush history at Columbia State Historic Park, see a live show at Fallon House Theatre, taste local wines at Inner Sanctum Cellars, and attend fun year-round events.

Town of Tuolumne – Game, stay, and play at Black Oak Casino Resort, visit the Tuolumne City Memorial Museum, and hike the scenic West Side Trail.



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
