Grab a bite to eat then end your stay with a ½ to 1 -hour horseback ride with Smith Station Stables at Firefall Ranch. Explore the adjacent and historic Burch Ranch. Get back in time to clean-up and head home.

Tuolumne County has two small-craft airports. The <u>Columbia Airport</u> which is within walking distance to <u>Columbia State Historic Park</u> and the other is <u>Pine Mountain Lake Airport</u> in Groveland, just 23 miles from the Big Oak Flat entrance to Yosemite National Park.
