


The 2022 Travel Trends Report by award-winning hospitality management software developer, <u>Cloudbeds</u>, revealed that travellers prefer to stay longer at a destination than prior to the pandemic. 44% of holiday goers stated they prefer trips of at least seven nights, whilst 26% would prefer a ten-night trip. 
Colorado, USA
